

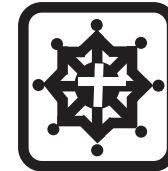

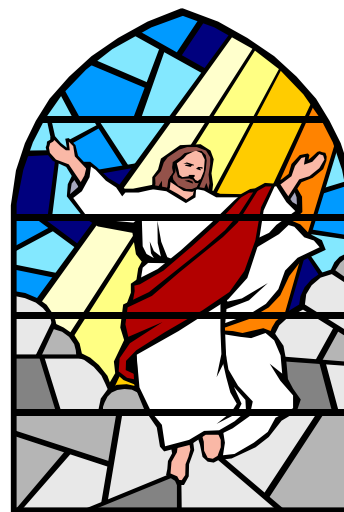

## **"Annual Congregational Meeting"**

The Official Board has been working to prepare for the leadership and financial needs of the church for the coming year. The church operating budget & slate of Officers is ready for review by the congregation. Copies are available on the table at the back of the sanctuary.

The Finance Committee was required to take a hard look at the church budget in light of our deficit situation. They worked to reduce the 2010 budget by 1.7%. The new proposed 2010 budget is \$190,200, this is down from \$193,500 in 2009. Anna Slaidins has requested that all Committees carefully think through expenditures and reduce spending where possible. The Board and Committee Chairs are open to being creative and resourceful with God's gifts for His Ministries offered through our church. Join us in asking for God's guidance in using the gifts He provides to continue the ministries He has called us to serve in, here at Greenmont-Oak Park Community Church.

We still have a couple Committee Chair positions open - Christian Education & Finance/Stewardship and Board Vice Chair. Please prayerfully consider and see if He is calling you to one of these positions in His church.
