If you have lost a spouse, child, family member or friend, you have probably found that there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel. You yourself may not understand the deep hurt you feel and why you can't get over it.

That is the reason for GriefShare, a special seminar and support group for people grieving the loss of someone close. This group is sponsored by people who understand what you are experiencing and want to offer you comfort and encouragement during this difficult time. Each of the thirteen GriefShare sessions includes a video seminar and group discussion. A GriefShare help-book assists you with note taking, journaling and grief study. The videos feature top experts on grief recovery, dramatic reenactments about living with grief and real-life stories of people who have experienced losses like yours.

During small group discussion time, you will have the opportunity to interact with others who have experienced a recent loss, learn about their experiences and share your own.

GriefShare is a nondenominational group and features biblical teaching on grief and recovery topics.

Just as God, the Father Son, and Holy Spirit comforted and helped the disciples learn how to live again after the death, resurrection, and ascension of Christ Jesus, God will help us learn how to journey from Mourning to Joy. Please join us for the next GriefShare session, which begins Thursday June 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 P.M. at Greenmont-Oak Park Church. Please register by May 27<sup>th</sup>. A donation of \$20.00 for registration and the study book is appreciated.

### Official Board March Highlights

Our March meeting was busy with sharing information and making decisions.

highlights were:

1- Congregational Planning Team report and work overview. This task force is looking at the results from the last Nov. congregational survey results. They are helping the Board to work on re-visioning efforts, and helping us find resources to assist the committee's in their specific work to "Increase and Maintain the attendance" here at our church. They shared some good information, and will work with us through the rest of the year.

2- The Easter Special offering recipients were decided. The offering will be divided 4 ways between: One Great Hour of Sharing, World Neighbors, Bread for the World, and The Good Neighbor House.

3- the Endowment Committee had 8 requests for funds to support outreach and Christian Education and church development needs. The Endowment Committee made their recommendations to the Board for use of approx. half of the Endowment interest funds available at this time. The Board also approved these recommendations.

4- Our church will be making three Neighborhood newsletter mailings over the coming year to invite and share news about our church and our activities. This year we will outreach to 728 residents in the Bauer—Watervliet—Highridge area and Newcome-Knolls area. (Last year we sent mailings out to the Greenmont Village and Oak Park areas.)
