Navy, during the Korean War.

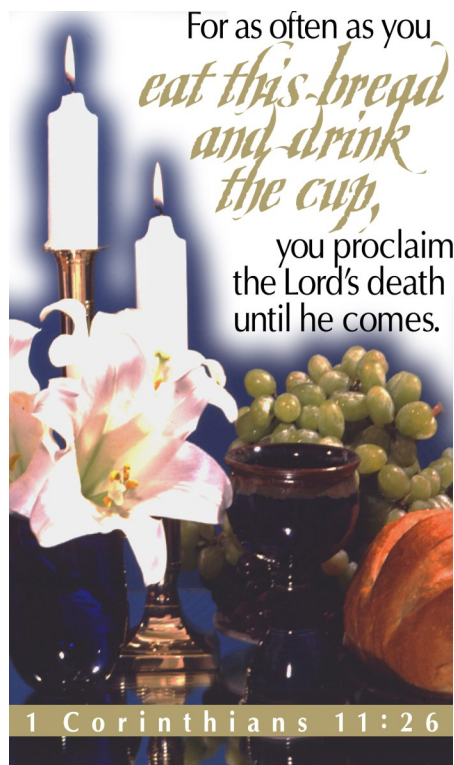
He will assume his new duties in June.
