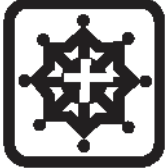

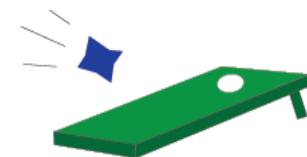
Kevin and Evelyn live in Kettering on San Rae Drive, they have a grown child, Lynn, who graduated from Fairmont High school in 2005.

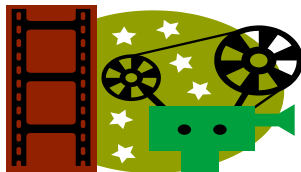
