This campaign is in addition to our annual stewardship campaign. We still need to meet our operating budget!

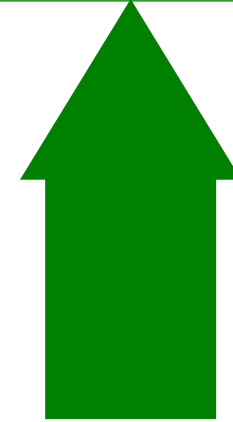
